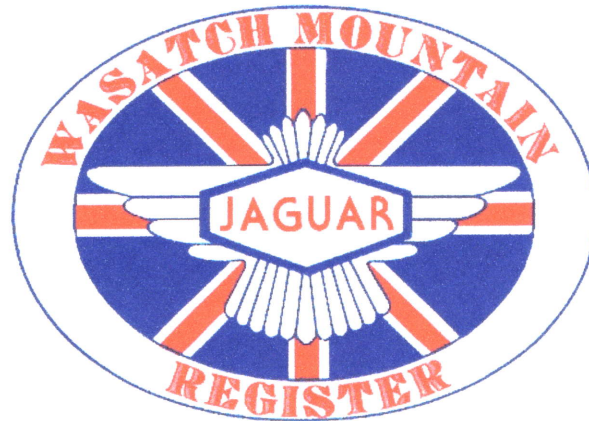

Hope to see you at the tour to Taggarts' Restaurant.





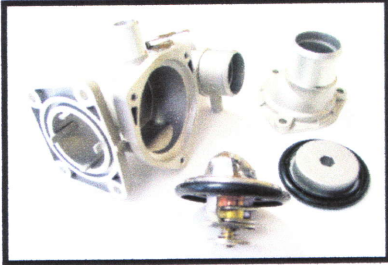
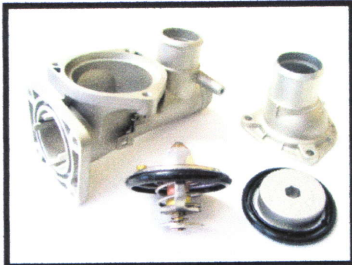
