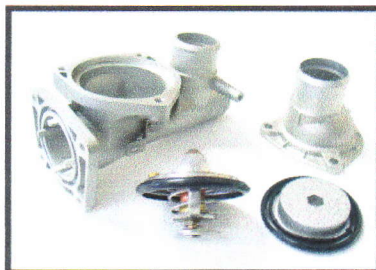

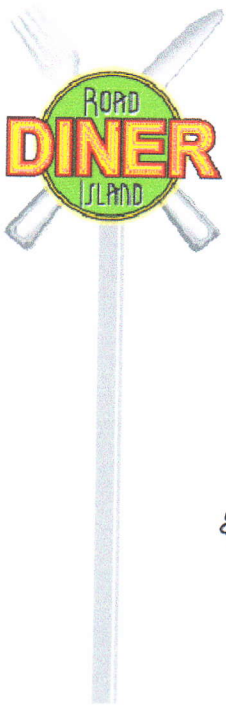

What to bring: Light jacket, Jaguar car, camera, and an appetite.

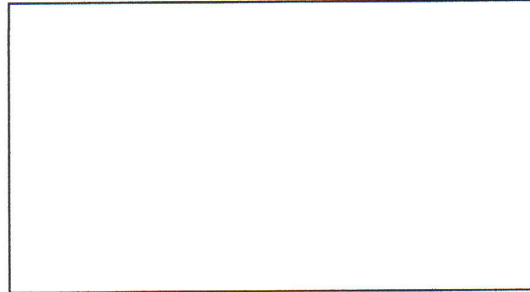
Where to meet: Thanksgiving Point Golf Course entrance on N. Garden Dr.
