Show History

This annual event has been staged for many years by the <u>Bonneville Austin Healey Club</u>, with the help of participating Utah car clubs, including the <u>Wasatch Mountain Jaguar Register</u> and the British Motor Club of Utah.

This year the WMJR is again taking the organizational lead, while still welcoming help from other clubs, including the BAHC and the BMCU.

Details

The venue will be lower Main Street in Park City UT. Over 60 cars will be shown. The show is open to the general public for viewing at no cost.

The show is primarily focused on classic and vintage British and European cars but original American examples and newer British and European "supercars" will be present.

Awards:

- · A *People's Choice* winner will be determined by popular vote of car owners and the general public.
- · Classes will be determined by the mix of applicants. In 2016 the classes included *British*, *Vintage Jaguar*, *Modern Jaguar*, *Austin Healey*, *Porsche 911*, *Porsche 356*, *Exotic*, *Ultra Exotic* and *American Classic*.
- · Best of Class and Class (runner up) awards will be selected by vote of those showing cars, as well as an overall Best of Show.
