its systems were working properly using Gary's Sun Engine Analyzer, the forum was turned over to Barry, who employed his nifty Innovate Motor Systems ex-

haust air / fuel analyzer to confirm the richness hypothesis and guide the leaning out. In the end the TD was purring like the proverbial kitty.

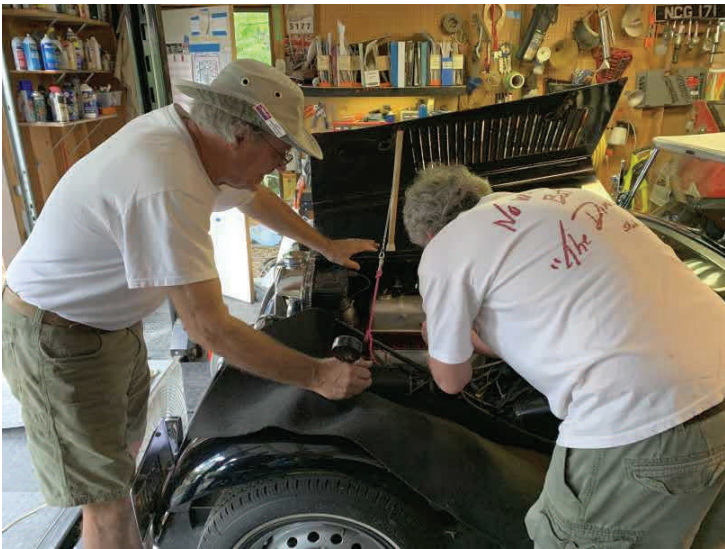
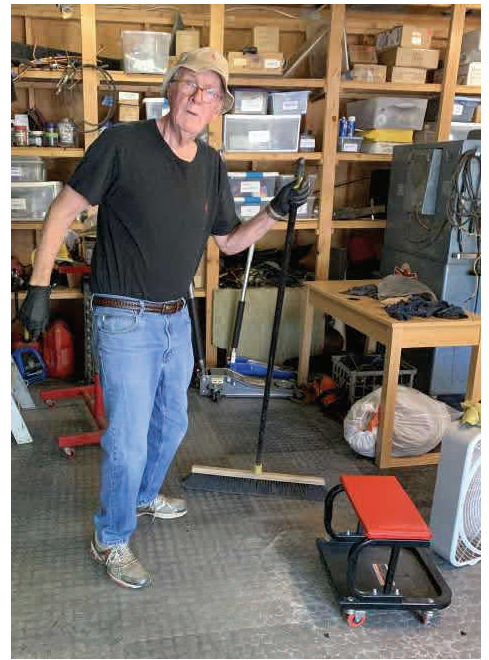
Attending were Bud Merritt, Ken Borg, Arnold Antell, Duane Allred and new member Andy Betts from the WMJR.

From the BMCU there were Don Kent, Larry Farrington, Jon Hermance, and Pugs Pivirotto.

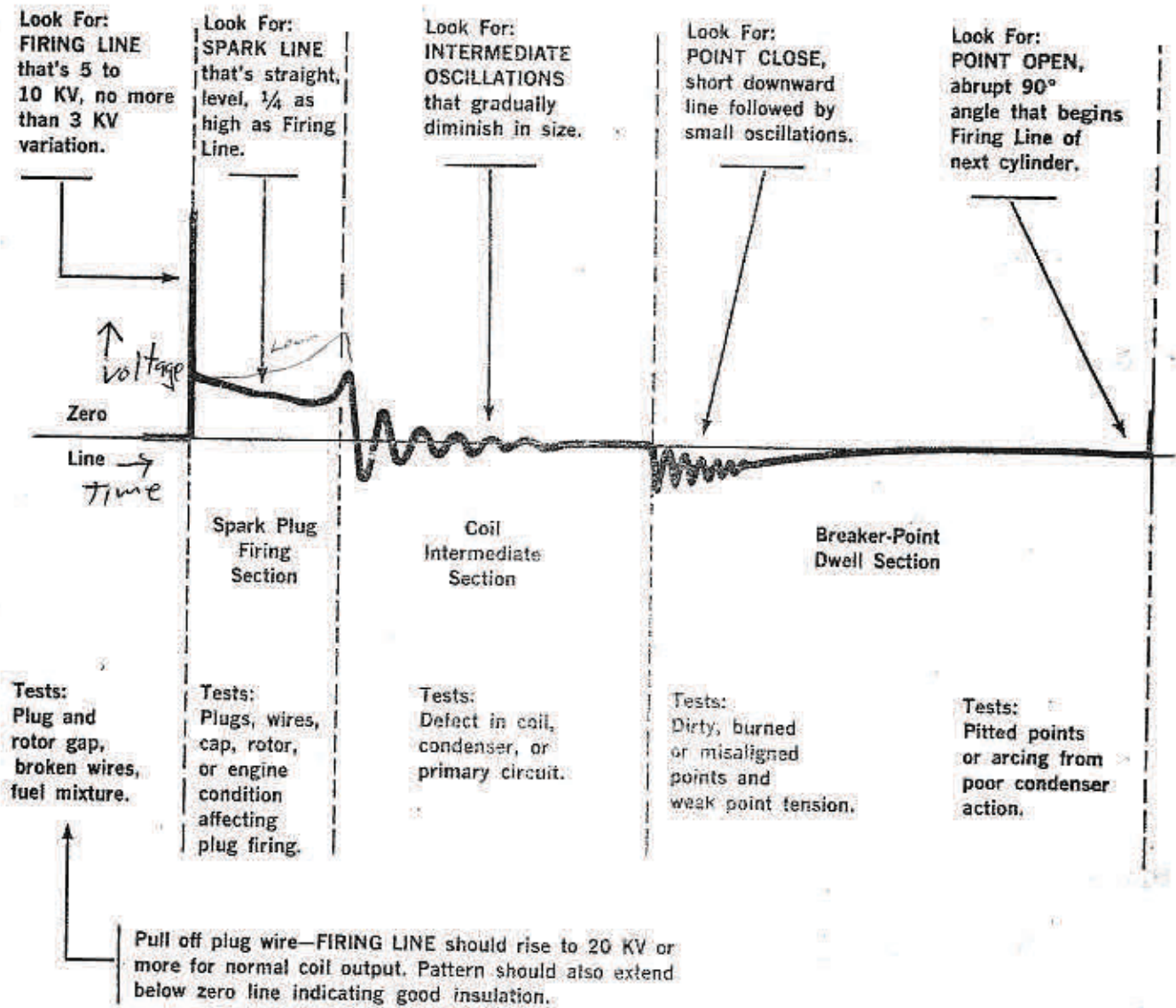
As mentioned the presenters were Barry Hanover and Your Obedient Scribe.

Sun Scope Pattern



From the Sun Engine Analyzer manual, showing the desired life cycle of a cylinder firing. Notable are the initial spike as the points open, the slow decline as the spark dissipates, the near zero voltage thereafter, and finally the coil recharge section after the points close (the "dwell").

This event is unique in Utah in that it is a benefit for the Commemorative Air Force Wing at the Heber City Airport, and offers photo opportunities pairing cars with vintage aircraft.
