



Scholarship for the Society of Women Engineers National Conference

Eligibility Requirements

Candidates must be:

- Enrolled in their junior or senior year of undergraduate study at a university in the United States
- In Computer Science, Computer Engineering, or related technical field major
- Maintaining a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale or 4.5 on a 5.0 scale or equivalent in their current program
- Attending the SWE National Conference on November 3-5, 2005 in Anaheim, California
