Application Deadline: March 1st by 5:00 p.m. (postmark)

Selection:

Applicants will be notified of a decision via US Mail. Letters are sent around the 1st week of April.

Application packet must contain

A completed, signed, application form (complete 4th page for financial need-based scholarships)

A current one (1) page resume that focuses on engineering related work (i.e. jobs, internships, etc) and extracurricular activities (volunteer service, affiliation with engineering related societies and clubs)

Essay and/or Personal Statement ***Some scholarships may require both a personal statement and an essay. Please note, you may have to write more than one essay if you wish to be considered for a specific scholarship***

Transcript. U of U students may print out an “unofficial transcript” from the student system, with transfer summary if applicable. DARS will be accepted from U of U students.

Two (2) letters of recommendation – must be academic letters (ME and ECE students should check their department instructions).

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed!

Students who receive a scholarship, fellowship, or other financial aid administered by the University of Utah are required by state law to certify that they are eligible to receive the scholarship as a U.S. citizen or a citizen of another country who is lawfully present in the U.S. If students do not know whether they are in the U.S. lawfully, they should seek the advice of an immigration attorney before filing a scholarship/financial aid application.

Prior to the disbursement of any scholarship/financial aid, the University of Utah is required by law to verify the recipient’s citizenship status or lawful presence in the U.S. with the Department of Homeland Security (DHS). Once the University submits a student’s information to DHS for verification, this federal agency may have the legal right to share the information with other government agencies. By signing this application, I certify under penalty of perjury that I am either a U.S. citizen or a citizen of another country who is lawfully present within the U.S.
