Applications for the School of Computing Graduate Travel Award are invited from School of Computing graduate students whose research have been accepted for presentation at a professional meeting. The award is contingent upon applicant presenting at the meeting. All applications must be submitted a least one-month prior to the dates of travel.

Awards are on a competitive basis chosen by the Graduate Studies Committee. Selection criteria include: 1 – quality of the project, 2- significance of the research in its discipline, and 3- impact of attendance and meeting presentation on the graduate student's career. The committee attempts to fund according to need and the amount of the award may vary.

3. _____ a copy of the official abstract and paper submitted for the meeting.
4. _____ an additional page from the applicant describing the (a) presentation (b) impact of the travel grant to the applicant, and (c) proposed budget.
5. _____ Submission of other sources for the proposed travel (e.g. Graduate School Travel Award, project funding, etc.)
6. _____ endorsement from advisor.
