
The Jaguar Conspiracy

Paris Seeks Ban On Older Cars Reported By [High Gear Media](#) November 14, 2012

For some, the image of a classic Citroën DS passing along the Champs-Élysées couldn't be much more French if a man in a striped top and beret walked past swinging a chain of onions.

But that image could soon be shattered as Paris Mayor Bertrand Delanoë readies plans that ban all pre-1997 cars from the city's streets in bid to curb pollution.

The plans have angered classic-car fans, whose vehicles make up only three percent of the vehicles on Parisian roads, about 365,000 cars, according to *Reuters*.

It would take some of France's most distinctive vehicles off the streets, including such iconic vehicles as the aforementioned Citroën DS, the 2CV, the Peugeot 205 GTI hot hatchback and the dependable Renault 4L, along with dozens of others.

Others complain that it would prevent those who are simply unable to afford anything newer from driving around the city.

In 2010, Paris tried out a ban of gas-guzzling off-road vehicles from its



streets. The latest scheme has been described as "another hair brained idea" to please ecologists and wealthy Parisians, according to Claude Fauconnier, vice-president of the French Friends of the 2CV Club.

The mayor, whose previous initiatives

have included Paris's bike-sharing scheme, Velib' (partner of the Autolib' electric-car sharing service), has been accused previously of turning the capital into a "playground for the rich."

Delanoë defends the latest move, which he says "is for our citizens – it's a public-health battle and we've been fighting since 2001 to try and make the air here more breathable."

Several other cities around the world have introduced similar initiatives in recent years. The Emirate of Dubai has banned all cars older than 20 years from its roads to reduce pollution, while cars driving into the German city of Frankfurt have to meet a minimum European emissions standard.

If the Parisian proposal gains ministerial approval in January, it will go into force in 2014.

XK 65 in 2013

The sensational star of the 1948 Earls Court Motor Show, the iconic Jaguar XK 120 celebrates 65 glorious years in 2013.

“It is our intention to celebrate this landmark in suitable style,” says Jaguar author and XK Club founder, Philip Porter.

“Traditionally, we have had the world's largest annual gathering of XKs in the UK but for XK65 we decided Luxembourg would be an ideal venue. It is a lovely country with some great driving roads and it is easily accessible for so many European countries including, of

the course, the UK.”

The idea came from the Club's European Representatives and groups, whether members or not, are being encouraged to join in from every country for the day or weekend. Dinner on the Saturday evening will be at *Vianden Castle* and the main gathering at Echternach is on the Sunday, June 9, with a driving day on the Saturday. UK Rejoices: English Is Now The Preferred European Language

The European Union commissioners have announced that agreement has been reached to adopt English as the preferred language for European communications, rather than German, which was the other possibility.

As part of the negotiations, Her Majesty's Government conceded that English spelling had some room for improvement and has accepted a five-year phased plan for what will be known as EuroEnglish (Euro for short).


